ORGANISATION'S APPROACH TO DEMENTIA CARE

Namaste program

We have launched Namaste Care in August 2018 in our homes. We were the first in West Sussex to launch such a program which specializes in sensory approach when engaging with residents with dementia by stimulating their senses- touch, taste, sight and hearing. We offer spa days, aromatherapy sessions, light chair exercises touch/textures therapy including activities that uses lights and sounds. We have taken in Cancer hospice patients and have supported them and their families in this difficult time. The End-of-Life Namaste Care Program for People with Dementia is designed to give more compassionate and dignified care to older people with advanced dementia towards end of life.

Footprints

We are also the first home in Sussex to launch Intergenerational Care which links pre-schoolers to the older generation. Footprints project was launched in February'20, which is an Inter-generational project with preschool children visiting our homes every month for a storytelling session with their older friends. For our residents this enables them overcome loneliness and gives them a sense of purpose.

Dementia Cafes

We support Dementia Action Alliance (DAA), Alzheimer's society as well as the local dementia cafe/ Memory Cafe. All of which are organizations with similar vision as Ashton in ensuring that those living with dementia and their Carers have a good quality of life with access to information and support.

Case studies for Dementia residents

We undergo case studies for residents with behavioural challenges. Every Friday, a staff will present a case study of their selected resident and does a presentation to staff.

Interactive table and use of technology

We have 'interactive table'. We purchased an Interactive mobile table in 2020 to enhance activities in room and small group activities following social distancing policies.

We are experienced Nursing Home Operators since 2004 and have had Good CQC inspection reports for all our established 4 nursing homes in Sussex. As well as Investors in People Gold Award in all our homes. Ashton Meadows is our 5th home. This new home will have an acute, post-operative care wing and also a dementia nursing wing located less than a 100 yards from Kingston hospital.

EXPERIENCED NURSING STAFF TEAM

Nicola Ambler, Regsitered Mental Health Nurse with over 30 years experience and a Senior manager at the Ashton group, will be leading this flagship nursing home. She will be supported by 2 deputy nurse managers who have worked for 5 years as deputies within the Ashton group. The team will have 10 of our existing senior nurses from Sussex lead the floor, with their nurse station located through out the home in all the separate nursing sections, 24 hours per day.

Our experienced staff team tailor the care dependent on the needs of each individual resident whether is palliative end of life care, dementia nursing care or any type of nursing care. The key to truly good care is the kindness and experience. Our staff are trained in Namaste Care, a person centred support through sensory stimulation and meaningful activity.
